INTRODUCTION

This document explains how to install and use the Advanced headers Web part application on your SharePoint Online site.

To continue on this document, you must have added the application "Advanced headers" by Eruditego on from the SharePoint Store to your tenant store (validation that should be done by the IT service). You also need to have design permission on site you want to update.

INSTALLATION

To install the Advanced headers Web Part, follow the steps:

- Connect to your SharePoint site
- Go on site content
- Click on "New" > "Application"
- On application "Advanced headers" click on "Add"

After a few minutes, application shall be deployed on the site. You need now to add the web part to a page, here are the steps :

- Edit any page you need;
- You can remove existing header if needed
- Click to add a new web part in the page (you can add it to a full width zone);
- Look for "Advanced header Web Part" and add it



The application is ready to use.

USAGE


To edit the Advanced header web part, edit the page where the web part is added. The web part goes in edit mode :



The first step to do is to select the type of header you'd like to create. You can choose between the different options available. To do so:



- Edit web part properties
- In section "Header type" select the header type you'd like to use



On this configuration tab you can also change different parameters :

- Header height: The height of the header is controlled to let you decide what space you reserve for it
- Header background color: to allow you choose more color than the current 4 options of the standard
- Header background opacity: to allow you have color blend with background of the page
- Header background image: to integrate an image into your header
- Header radius: to generate round corner on your header

The base of your header is now set up

COMMON CONFIGURATIONS

Each part of the headers are configurable with the same technic. The part has 2 side buttons that allow you control their behavior and display :



The actions allow you to:

- Move the component in the header vertically and horizontally. Note that the horizontal position of the part is calculated from the center, to be able to adapt depending on the screen size.
- Resize horizontally the part, note that the vertical size is adapting according to the content.
- Design the component, note that this part is dependent on the part you work on

TITLE PART

The title part display a text that you can manage in term of design and content:





When writing your text, you can change the text size (using the drop down menu), weight, style, decoration and alignment.

Using the design button you can also change the text color, background color, transparency and corner radius.

CALL TO ACTION PART

The call to action part allow you to create a clickable button:



When writing your text, you can change the text size (using the drop down menu), weight, style, decoration and alignment.

Using the design button you can also change the text color, background color, transparency, corner radius and Url to redirect to. Note that if you don't provide any Url, your button won't work








Examples of button part with different designs

USER PART

The user part allow you to add a user information on your header:



When writing your text, you can choose the user to display. Once selected, the user will be shown inside the header.



Using the design button you can also change the text color, background color, transparency and corner radius. When a user will hover the user, it will display its account information.
